- Term 2 Outline -



Dear Parents and Carers,

Mr Beard, Miss Bowen and Mrs Watson, would like to welcome all the 5/6 students back for Term 2! We will continue to collaborate together, to ensure consistency in planning of programs and learning content. Please note for this term Mrs Onus will be teaching in Room 7 on Fridays in place of Mr Beard and Miss Bowen will be teaching for four days in Room 8.

Below is an outline of what is planned for this term.

Literacy Blocks:

During Literacy Blocks this term we will focus on reviewing narratives and expositions in preparation for NAPLAN. Later on in the term we will shift our focus to information reports and letter writing. These genres appear in specific learning areas, like History, which provide opportunities to integrate both speaking and listening and writing activities.

In order to best meet the students' needs, spelling and reading programs will continue to be differentiated, where the level of difficulty is adjusted. Guided reading will be used to both, support the learning in other subject areas and as a way of addressing students' comprehension.

Mathematics:

During Maths Mr Beard / Mrs Onus will be teaching all Year 5's and Miss Bowen / Mrs Watson will be teaching all Year 6's. This term we will be covering the following topics;

- Fractions
- Statistics and Probability
- Measurement and Geometry

HASS:

Both classes will be focusing on History. In this topic we will cover Colonisation and immigration in Australia. As previously mentioned, activities have been planned to integrate reading and writing with History. This will include the students creating information reports on Port Jackson and the Swan River settlements.

Science:

Mrs Anderson will continue to work with the Primary students in Science, teaching the Science Enquiry Skills strand with classroom teachers covering the Science Understanding strand. This term the students will be focusing on Earth and Space.

Health:

This term the students will be following the SDERA Challenges and Choices program which is from the Western Australian Curriculum. Students will gain knowledge and understanding in both resilience and road safety.

Technologies:

During Digital Technologies the students will study the individual components of the computer. This information will be used in Design and Technology where the students will create a 3D model of a computer in which they can demonstrate their understanding.

Visual Arts (Mrs Watson):

Visual will continue to be taught by Mrs Watson.

Physical Education (Mr Chipchase):

Physical Education will continue to be taught by Mr Chipchase.

Library:

These sessions are important as this is one of the only times the students have the opportunity to borrow books which can be used as home readers. Please make sure your child brings a library bag. Library bags can be purchased from the school in faction colours. Library days: Room 7 – Monday and Room 8 – Tuesday.

Homework Requirements:

Homework will be issued on Mondays and the students will need to return it on the following Monday to be marked.
