- Unit Outline Term 1 Skateboards -



Course Description:

You will look at the art of Japan from traditional to contemporary work. Specifically we will study Calligraphy, the use of Koi and Cherry Blossom in art, woodblock art, Geishas and Manga Art.

From the various periods studied you will develop your own Japanese inspired design.

Your design will then be drawn onto a skateboard deck, painted and varnished. When it's dry you can attach wheels and have your own original design skateboard.

Course Outcomes:

By the end of this unit students should be able to:

- Develop skills in calligraphy
- Develop skills in design work encompassing balance and looking at composition
- Gain an appreciation for the varied types of Japanese art
- Understand and recognise the relevance of Japanese art in history
- Develop skills in transferring a design to a different surface
- Develop skills in the use of paint pens

Course Organisation:

The organisation of the unit will be:

- Drawing and design development – 6 weeks
- Skateboard painting– 3 weeks
- Art History and critical analysis – 1 week

Students' activities will include:

- Exploring Japanese calligraphy
- Looking at the history of Japanese Art

Course Vocabulary:

- Japanese art, calligraphy, woodblock printing, origami manga
- Posca pen, balance, composition, lettering, spacing

Specific Equipment required for each lesson:

- All art equipment will be supplied by the Secondary Art Department
- Students should have their own art folio in which to keep their work. This collection of work forms part of the final mark
